**6** In the inflation cabinet, banknotes are being burned in a stove.

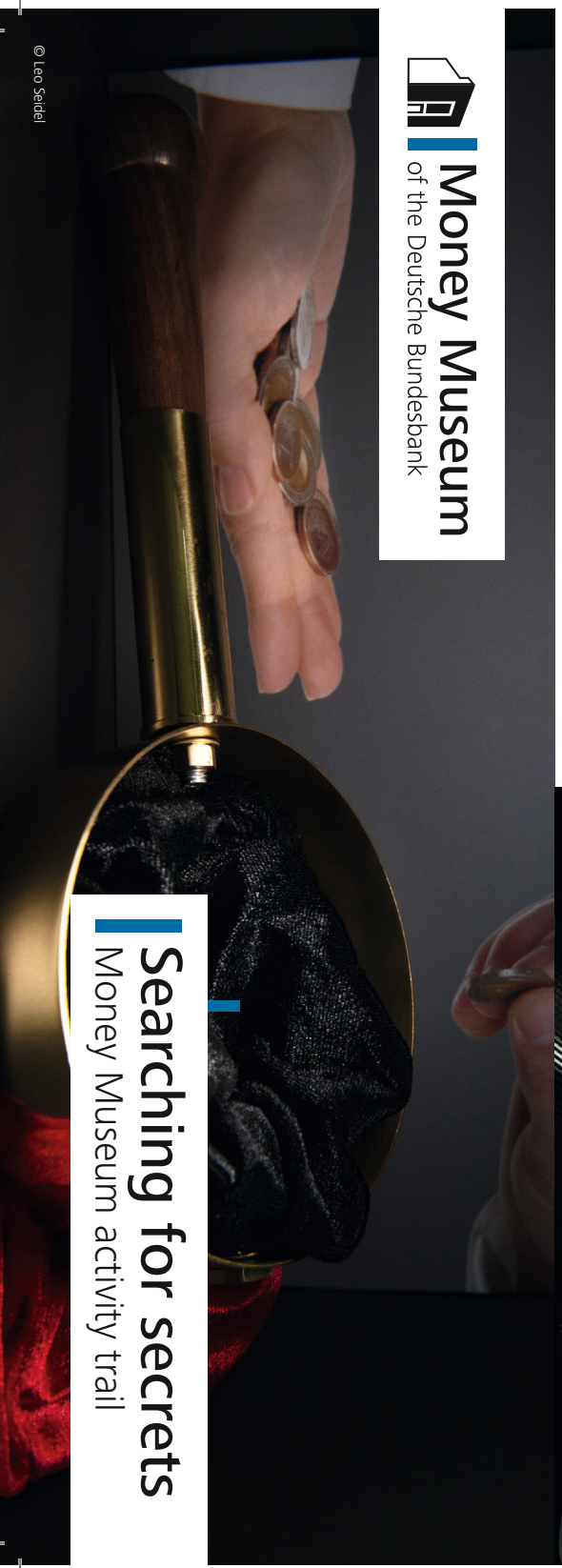

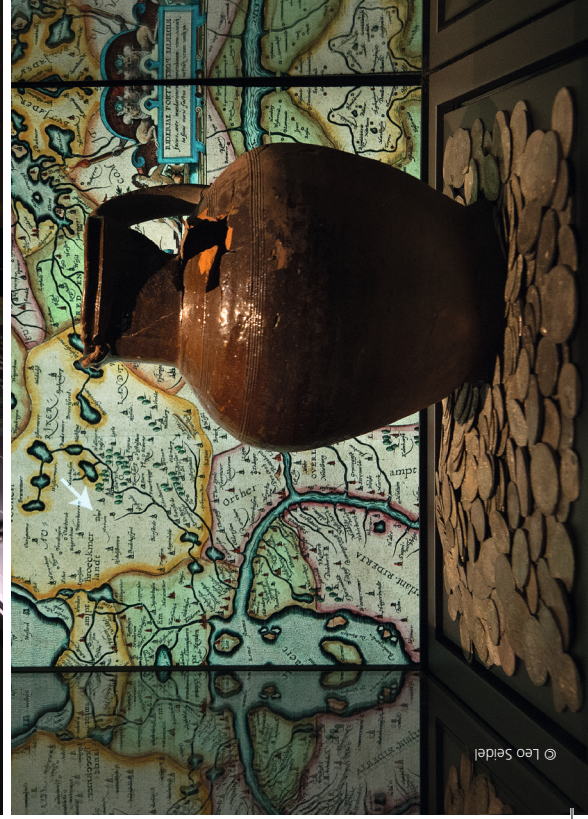
How many people can you see?
